Many positions are available, however, the number of youth volunteers assigned to an area may be limited. Some positions are restricted to adult or youth volunteers entering 9th grade and older (working with 3rd-6th graders) and some grade level positions are designated as adult volunteer only.

## What is Expected of a VBX Volunteer?

All VBX volunteers, regardless of position, are required to attend a VBX Volunteer Orientation Meeting. In addition, Youth volunteers are required to attend a Youth Information Party. Check your volunteer assignment postcard and registration form for meeting dates and times.

**All positions are filled at the discretion of the VBX Director.**

A VBX Volunteer is dedicated to sharing their faith with others!

VBX Volunteers are expected to:

- Make a best effort to be available the entire nine days of Vacation Bible Xperience.
- Show excitement and a positive attitude towards VBX and the children.
- Interact with and encourage the children.
- Use appropriate language and dress both appropriately and modestly.
- Adhere to these and all other guidelines set out in the volunteer information packet.
- Youth, realize that VBX is not intended to be a social event. It is an opportunity to minister to children. Please behave accordingly.



## Volunteer Positions

**Position:** Teacher/Co-Teacher  
4 year olds thru 6th grade

**Job Description:** The Teacher/Co-Teacher will team teach with another qualified adult or youth. Responsibilities include planning and implementing lessons during VBX, as well as accompanying the class to different activities the entire morning. The Classroom team is expected to meet *prior* to VBX to plan all aspects of classroom time.

**Age Requirement:** Youth Teacher/Co-Teachers must be entering 9th grade or older, and must have prior experience working with children during Sunday mornings or Vacation Bible Xperience. Refer to the Youth Volunteer Registration form for specific grade/age level.

**Position:**  
Classroom Helper  
4 year olds thru  
2nd grade

**Job Description:** The Classroom Helper assists the teacher/co-teachers in all aspects of VBX. You are expected to work with your assigned classroom team in planning and preparation.

**Age Requirement:** Classroom Helpers must be entering 7th grade or older. No previous experience working with children is required.

**Position:** Nursery Helper  
Infants thru 3 year olds

**Job Description:** Nursery Helpers assist the Nursery Supervisor and Staff in all aspects of providing a loving, caring and safe environment for the children of our VBX volunteers.

**Age Requirement:** Nursery Helpers must be entering 9th grade or older. Previous baby-sitting experience is suggested, as well as infant health and safety knowledge.

**Position:** Kitchen / Outreach Project

**Job Description:** Kitchen/Outreach Helpers assist both the Kitchen Supervisor and the Outreach Project Supervisor. Kitchen duties include set-up, delivery and clean-up of the daily snacks. Outreach Project duties include helping collect and organize the donated items/materials.

**Age Requirement:**  
Kitchen/ Outreach Project Helpers  
must be entering 7th grade or older.



**Position:** Special Area Helper -  
Crafts, Recreation, Music  
4 year olds thru 6th grade

**Job Descriptions:** Special Area Helpers assist the Special Area Leaders with all the activities of their area. Interaction with VBX children is required of all Special Area Helpers. Specific area tasks are as follows:

**Crafts:** Helpers assist with material preparation, set-up, and cleanup for daily crafts. They will also help VBX students with craft assembly.

**Music:** Helpers will be selected by the Music Director and will be providing assistance with teaching the VBX music.

**Recreation:** Helpers assist with all games and activities, set-up, and clean-up for daily recreation. Many recreation activities are outdoors.

**Age Requirements:** Special Area Helpers in crafts and music must be entering 7th grade or older. Recreation helpers must be 9th grade or older. Refer to the Youth Volunteer Registration form for specific grade/age level restrictions.
